- **RCIA: ENROLMENT FORM:** For adults who want to be baptized or received into the Catholic Faith next Easter. Programme to run every Tuesday beginning 30th October at 6pm for one hour. Baptism and reception is scheduled for Easter Vigil on 20th April 2019 at 8.30pm Mass.
- **Confirmation:** Children from Year 6 onwards are eligible to register. First Meeting involving parents and children will be on take place on Tuesday, 27th November from 4.30pm to 5.30pm. Second meeting involving children only will be at the same time on Tuesday, 4th December and enrolment on Sunday 9th December at 9.30am Mass. Confirmation will be on Sunday, 7th April 2019 at 11am.
- **Communion:** Children eligible to register must be from Year 3 onwards. First Meeting involving parents and children will be on take place on Monday, 3rd December from 4.30pm till 5.30pm. The second meeting will be at the same time on Monday, 10th December. Enrolment will be Sunday, 16th December at the 9.30am Mass. The First Holy Communion will be Sunday 19th May 2019.
